Background

Caterpillars was established in the 1960's when it was based at Eight Ash Green. In 2002, the group moved premises to St Andrew's Church in Marks Tey.

Caterpillars at Birch was opened in September 2009, after the successful bid from their sister pre-school at Marks Tey to run a pre-school at the purpose built log cabin which was built by Birch Primary school.

Ofsted last inspected Marks Tey in January 2020 where it was again rated as Outstanding (The full report is available to read on request or via our website).

Caterpillars is an ever evolving establishment, changing to meet children's needs, community needs and government policies and standards. In addition, we implement new ideas and change our practice as staff consistently undertaken on-going training. At Caterpillars, we all learn together and we learn from each other.

Session times and fees

Caterpillars is open for 38 weeks a year in line with local school term dates. We accept children from age 2 ½. We can at times accept children from the age of 2, where doing so doesn't impact on the required staffing need.

Caterpillars recommendation is that your child attends for a minimum of 2 morning sessions per week. Experience has shown that when children only attend for one session per week, it takes them longer to settle and adjust to the change to their home and pre-school routines. This ultimately means it takes them longer to fully engage and get the most out of their time with us.

We will always try and be flexible where we can so please discuss your requirements with the Manager.

Currently, parents are asked to provide a snack for their child but milk will be provided at morning snack time. When circumstances again permit, morning snacks will be provided and we will reintroduce cooking activities with the children.

Fees:

Fees are charged on a per session basis but based on the following hourly rates;

- Under 3's – £5.28 per hour 3.5 hour session £18.48
- Over 3's - £4.32 per hour 3.5 hour session £15.12

Our charges match those paid for Government Funded places and will be reviewed every April so they remain in line with Government funded rates.

All non-funded hours will be invoiced electronically on a half termly basis.

The under 3 year old rate (£5.28) will be charged until the half term after your child turns 3.

Funded Places

Parents can claim **15 hours** a week government funding for their child from the start of the full new term (Autumn, Spring, Summer) after the child's 3rd Birthday. Parents need to complete and sign a funding form at the start of each term. This covers the whole of the term and additional hours/sessions cannot be claimed for after the funding headcount date (around the middle of the month in which the term starts). If you wish your child to attend additional sessions after the headcount date, these will need to be paid for the remaining duration of that term.

Please visit www.childcarechoices.gov.uk to find out more about funding for your child's place and how to register to see if you are eligible to claim up to 30 hours funding.

For those parents that qualified for the childcare voucher scheme (closed to new parents in October 2018) we do accept childcare vouchers as a means of paying for Caterpillars fees.

Lunch clubs

Children attending lunch club bring their own lunch box. We take children from age 3 and offer pay as you go lunch session for the times where you may need an extra hour. You can also claim lunch clubs in the 15 hours of government funding allocated to your child.

The Team

We have two side rooms which we use for registration rooms the 2 year old children have the Caterpillar Room and the 3 and 4 year olds have the Butterfly Room.

Whilst with us your child's key person will be following your child's progress through the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum (EYFS) The Key person plots this progress through small daily observations and taking photographs and put's this all together to make your child's Learning Journey.

The EYFS curriculum consists of seven areas and these are:

Each activity and area set out for the children supports your child in each of these areas.

At the end of each term we invite all parents in to view your child's learning journey each child has an end of term report which we hope parents will make a comment on and sign.

A list is on display in reception for parents to see which key practitioner your child is with. We are happy to discuss concerns or other issues throughout their time at Caterpillars.
